Registration

Camper Ages:

Children must be at least 5 years of age by May '09 and at most 14 years of age before September '09.

Please register your children for camp according to the grade they will enter in the next school year.

Sessions per Child:

To allow for many camp participants, children may only attend one session during the week registered for.

Fees:

K - 2 Grade camps: \$50 per camper
3 - 8 Grade camps: \$75 per camper

Fees help cover camp expenses such as art and craft materials, guest speakers, camper gifts, and snacks.

*As a nonprofit organization, we sincerely appreciate **any** funds donated above the camp fee. Or, consider having your child bring [donated items](#) for the shelter on their first day of camp!*

Registration Due Date:

Camp space each week is limited and registration is conducted on a rolling basis until camps fill. Please submit registrations quickly. Accepted registrations will receive a timely notice of camp placement.

Completed registration forms can be submitted via mail, fax, or email.

No phone registrations please.

Waiting Lists:

Registrations received after a camp week has filled will go on a waiting list in the event a space opens.

To ensure quality of experience for the campers, children will not be placed in open weeks that do not fit their age/grade level.

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Payment & Cancellation

Payment Due Date:

Payment is due within two weeks of email confirmation of camp placement. If payment is not received within this time, the camp placement(s) may be lost.

NHES accepts debit/credit card, cash, or check. Payments can be made by mail, fax, or email.

Cancellations:

A cancellation fee of 25% is applied to cancellations made at least 14 days prior to the start of a registered camp date.

Cancellations made less than 14 days from the start of a registered camp date will not be refunded.

NHES and the BAAC reserve the right to cancel camp(s) and/or session(s). If a camp and/or session is cancelled, a full refund will be provided.

Correspondence

Registration:

Completed registration forms can be submitted via mail, fax, or email.

No phone registrations please.

Email:

To expedite the registration process, all correspondence following a submitted registration will be conducted by email, unless by mail or phone is needed.

This includes the confirmation email, camp details, pre-week reminders, and post-week follow-ups.

Changing Sessions

If space allows, changing a registered session *within a camp week* is possible at no addition cost.

If NHES cancels a camp and/or session, but space is available in another week, we may make an effort to re-register children to open sessions. (To ensure quality of experience for the campers, the normal registration process will not place children in open weeks that do not fit their age/grade level.)

Children with Special Needs

We welcome children of all background and will work to accommodate campers with special needs within our ability to do so. We may request parental or guardian assistance to help us achieve that goal.
